

## **Flat River Work Camp II is Coming to Greenville.**

More than 400 youth and adult volunteers from across this nation will come to Greenville on July 22, 2012 to work on 65-70 houses at absolutely no cost to the resident.

Workcamps are intensive one-week trips that help people grow in Christian faith through service. Individuals and youth from around the country will spend one week in our community performing hands-on home-repair projects for elderly, low-income, and disabled families. The work at each home will be done by 5 young people, and at least one adult leader, representing many Christian denominations. Eligible repair projects may include:

- Porch repair/construction
- Step repair
- Exterior painting
- Interior painting
- Weatherization
- Wheelchair ramp repair/construction
- Mobile home skirting
- Roofing (no tear offs)

The Workcamp's base station will be the Greenville Middle School. Both labor and materials are free to qualifying households. See attached application.
